Relatively new in the Korea academic circle, Hanseo University was founded in 1992 to strive for creativity, confidence and contribution. Located on the peaceful hillside of Mt. Gaya, adjacent to Seosan City in Chungnam Province, Hanseo University is an academic community where 8,500 students pursue their academic goals in one of its 50 departments that are staffed by 250 full-time faculty members. From the outset, in tune with the growing importance of globalization, the University has focused on offering innovative, specialized educational opportunities.

Thanks to its top quality facilities and congenial academic environment, Hanseo University's devoted efforts to deliver the finest teaching and learning resources have been acknowledged by the Korean Council for University Education. The University is strategically located on the West Coast of the peninsular, which is in the limelight because of its importance in the overall national development plan. Hanseo University exchanges students and faculty through sister relations with 58 universities in 12 countries, and around 500 foreign students study at the school. The international Red Cross Youth scholarships in particular, started in 2001 and selects young Red Cross members from Asian Pacific countries with the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies and the Republic of Korea National Red Cross. The scholarship provides students with a four-year scholarship to produce global talents who will spread a mind of humanitarianism and make Korea known to the world. The Institute of the Korean Language and Culture provides five stages of Korean language classes from beginner to advanced including listening, speaking and writing. It trains experts who understand Korean society and culture through hands-on education, including field trips.

Fly Higher and Higher for Your Dream.

Hanseo University spotlights the unique strategic 2A program of Aeronautics and Arts and has produced future specialists in these areas.

The Division of Aeronautical Studies is composed of seven academic departments, including Aeronautical Engineering, Flight Operation, Air Transportation and Administration. The Department of Helicopter Operation was first established in our country to produce specialists on the design, maintenance and operation of helicopters. All of the Air Tourism and Service students, future flight attendants, live in English only on-campus housing. The Taeon Air Field operates an after-school English program to enhance the international competitiveness.

□ Specialized Education in Aeronautics Taeon Airfield, the first in Asian Universities

Taeon Air Field, a general aviation education center, is located near Sinon-li Nam-myeon Taeon-gun with an area of 495,000m². Its runway is an F level with a length of 1.2 km and a width of 25 m. This is the first of its kind among colleges in Asian countries. It has flight facilities including the Flight Education Center, the Institute for Air Traffic Control Education, and the Aero Technical Education Center to produce aviation talents ranging from pilots to ground crews. It is equipped with 11 single-engined cessnas, a 19 person's double-engined 1999D, a 9 person's King Air, a 6 person's cessna and helicopters. It has also a simulator to heighten some efficiency of night flights.

□ Air Force ROTC, National Defence Elite

Hanseo University operates an Air Force ROTC to produce Air Force officers who will be in the service in the areas of flight, aircraft maintenance, air control, etc. Students with quality, both academically and physically, are eligible to apply for the program, and the selected cadets will get military training both on the campus and at the barracks.

□ Academy-Industry Collaboration with Airline Companies

We have formed an academy-industry collaboration agreement with Asiana Airlines, to train pilots and promote cooperation. Students from the Department of Flight Operation who meet agreed standards and complete the education and training program while at school may enter Asiana Airlines, according to mid to long-term pilot recruiting plans of the company.

Let's Turn the World Around.

The Division of Fine Arts manages another axis of specialized education, and includes eight academic departments such as fashion design, animation film, children's art education, interior design, industrial design, drama and cinema, contemporary music, and conservation of cultural heritage, which provide education that focuses on both theory and practice. We especially stress that practical education is most important to become experts in the arts fields in the future, and are working to develop creativity and a mind of creation so our students will become leaders of Korean culture and arts development. The Division of Fine Arts aims to make art a part of daily life and holds exchange exhibitions with its sister universities in China such areas as architectural design, painting and fashion design to offer opportunities to widen their global perspectives and experience different cultures.

□ Product Surface Design Innovation Center

The Product Surface Design Innovation Center provides one-stop design service through a comprehensive design support system such as design research and development, design equipment support and help to found design businesses. In the Center, the process from an idea sketch to 2D or 3D rendering and surface treatment design and model design are executed in a short time. It engages in helping local small and medium companies according to local strategic industries.

In July, 2008, it was selected as one of the nine best places out of 422 industrial foundation establishment business spots by the Ministry of Knowledge Economy, and an article was published in the examples of good cases book by the Korea Institute of Industry Technology Evaluation and Planning. It has applied for and registered 85 designs and seven patents for intellectual property rights, and was selected by the Korea Institute of Design Promotion as a capstone design business and design consulting business.

□ Cultural Heritage Conservation Science Center

The Center aims to conserve the cultural heritage by studying, researching and preserving our valuable cultural assets with traditional and scientific methods and educating students in this field. There are four major research fields - excavation; preservation, which repairs and restores cultural assets including metals, pottery, and stones; materials analysis, which analyzes artifacts, and researches materials and production methods; and education, which includes training local residents to be cultural asset treatment experts.

□ Sculpture Park : Art and Nature

A sculpture park beautifies the lawn area in front of Ingokgwan, the student residential hall along the main road of the campus. Numerous bronze, marble, and granite statues, including Pak Chuljun's Mother and Son, and Lee Sanggwon's Landscape of Daekokli, titillate the aesthetic sense. Art and the natural beauty of the surrounding mountains mingle to create an atmosphere that stimulates students' creative energies. Over the years, the park will continue to expand, growing into a splendid outdoor museum.

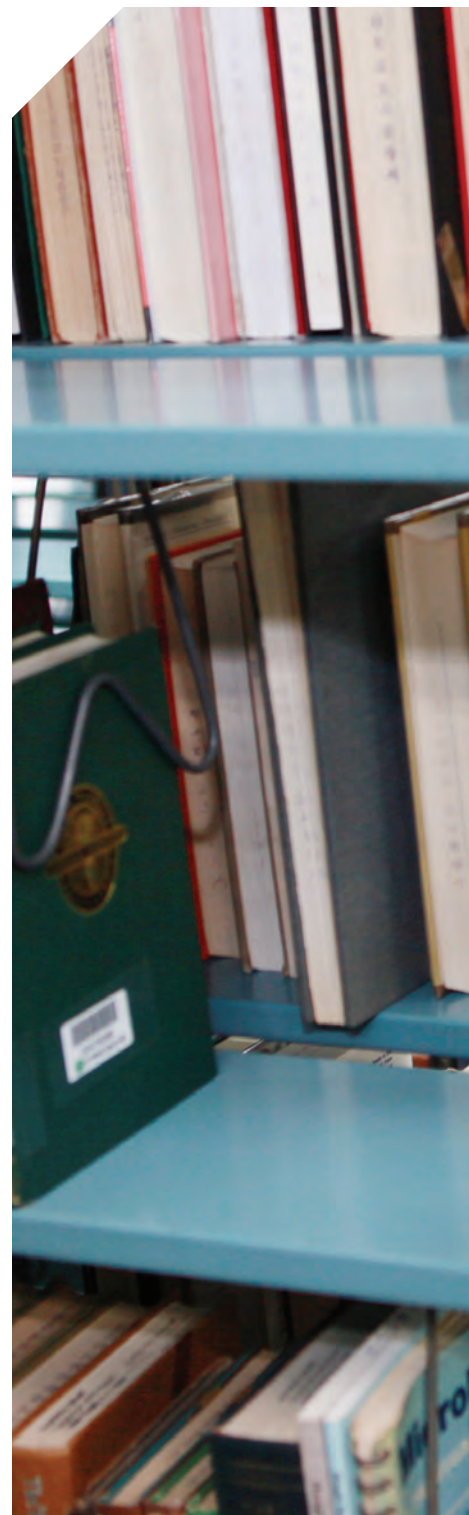

Graduate School



We train global Hanseo students to make the world their stage.

We provide various teaching methods and programs on speaking, listening, reading and writing so overseas students studying at the school and Koreans living overseas can study the Korean language and culture.

Importance of Korea and the Korean language is especially growing in this global age and in international society. With more people trying to learn Korean language and culture, we are moving beyond existing basic conversation and listening programs and providing more specific classes such as 'Everyday Korean' and 'Korean Practice' and providing 'Learning Korean through Music' to guide more active articulation.

There are also credit classes in the undergraduate program. Classes such as 'Beginners Korean (3 credits)', 'Intermediate Korean conversation (2 credits)', 'Advanced Korean (3 credits)' and 'Advanced Korean conversation (2 credits)' allow people who major in Korean to develop into Korean experts through in-depth studies. In addition, there are 'Korean culture (3 credits)' and 'Korean practice (1 credit)' classes, and 'Korean and Korean society (3 credits)' is a class taught in English, which is a point of attention because students can learn both of the languages at once.

The diverse and abundant programs of the Institute aim to help students find employment in Korean companies or companies related to Korea business in addition to their field of major. They are taught not only by language major instructors, but also a total of 11 instructors who major in Korean culture, history and other specific fields.

Curriculum

Additional classes in Korean history and culture provide the students with opportunities to explore historic sites and get acquainted with the 5000-year history of this country. Students also experience Korean culture through traditional folk art, including pansori (narrative song), food and tea customs.

▣ Product Surface Design Innovation Center (PSDIC)

The Center creates design infrastructure based on a unique digital process, and was heralded in the Ministry of Commerce, Industry and Energy's "Regional Industry Newsletter" as a model of success in design innovation based on the cooperation of industry, government and academy.

The Institute is devoted to a commercialization of catalytic process technology on the basis of an organic cooperation between industry, academy, laboratory and government. RICT's analysis center also supports researches and developments of catalyst technology, which has not yet been developed enough.
